INT. STORE - DAY

It's an immaculate and organized eyewear store. Nobody is inside, and a vast silence surrounds the store. At the counter, there's an iPad, but it's off. In one corner of the store, there's something similar to a tower, but its screen is also off.

Suddenly, a hand reaches the iPad and switches it on. The Tower turns on simultaneously. We hear a deep man's voice.

DAVID (V.O.)

With great power comes great responsibility.

The camera, starting from the hand, reveals David's face. He is a 35/40 Store Associate with a friendly and very smirky face.

DAVID

Imagine a boundless space with thousands of sun and optical models displayed. This is Smartshopper.

He raises the iPad and shows it to the camera. The camera gets closer and closer to the screen as if we are diving into it.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We are now inside the Smartshopper interface.

DAVID (V.O.)

The Smartshopper tool is an instore digital shopping assistant. It's intuitive and engaging and can help us create an immersive, Taylor-made customer experience!

Many sun and optical models scroll through, giving the idea of an infinite selection.

INT. STORE - AT THE COUNTER

We re-emerge from the iPad, and we're back again with David.

DAVID

But, to really master it, you must know all its incredible potential.

INT. STORE - DOOR ENTRANCE

Five different kinds of customers enter the store, one at a time. The scene restarts every time a new customer walks in.

We first see the FASHION LOVER, a woman in a cream-white, knee-length dress and a high ponytail. The words "Fashion Lover" appear next to her.

The second is THE CLASSIC, a man smartly dressed in a simple but elegant suit. The words "The Classic" appear next to him.

The third is THE SPORTY, a woman in a running suit and sneakers. The words "The Sporty" appear next to her.

The fourth is THE CASUAL, a man dressed in a simple white t-shirt and jeans. The words "The Casual" appear next to him.

The fifth is THE TECH LOVER, a man with quite a nerd style, eyeglasses, a plaid shirt, and a backpack. The words "The Tech Lover" appear next to him.

DAVID (V.O.)

You will meet a lot of different kinds of customers.

INT. STORE - AT THE COUNTER

Back with David.

DAVID

And for each one of their needs, you must know what the best Smartshopper feature is!

INSERT: INTERACTION BETWEEN DAVID AND THE CUSTOMERS

The Classic watches the iPad with David. David shows him how to engrave his glasses.

The Sporty compares different kinds of lenses on the iPad with David.

The Fashion Lover at the Tower uses the Frame Advisor.

The Casual engages with the Virtual Mirror on his phone.

The Tech Lover at the Tower compares two different kinds of models' technologies and lenses.

INT. STORE - AT THE COUNTER

Back with David.

DAVID

So, do you wanna become a Smartshopper pro or what? Well then, let's hit the road!

David smirks at the camera.

FADE OUT.

Smartshopper\_The indecisive customer

INT. STORE - DAY

A woman, LAURA, is looking at the shelves. She tries on two or three pairs of sunglasses, but she seems not convinced. She continues to look around.

David is behind the counter, watching her. He turns to the camera.

DAVID

There we are. An indecisive customer. Let's see what she needs!

David approaches Laura, carrying his iPad.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Hello, and welcome! How's your day been so far?

LAURA

Hi! Pretty great, thanks!

DAVID

Good! Is there something I can do for you?

LAURA

Well, I came in with the idea of buying something different than usual, but I'm having quite a hard time finding something I like.

David starts talking to the camera. The customer doesn't seem to hear the conversation.

DAVID

(to the camera)

It's time to unleash our secret weapon!

Then back to Laura.

DAVID (CONT'D)

I see. Tell me: is there any particular brand you'd like to try?

LAURA

I've always liked Ray-Ban, even if I've never had a pair...

David starts using his iPad while listening and nodding to Laura.

OK, please take a look at this.

He shows Laura the iPad.

LAURA

What is it?

DAVID

What you're looking at is our countless selection of Ray-Ban sunglasses. Every model available is inside this Smartshopper tool. Have you ever heard of it?

LAURA

No, never!

DAVID

It's a convenient digital tool with a catalog of countless models for you to choose from. I've now selected every Ray-Ban sunglasses at disposal, but we can further narrow the selection. Would you like to go on?

LAURA

Yeah, ok, let's try!

Laura now looks interested in David's iPad. David half smiles at the camera.

DAVID

(to the customer)
OK, so what kind of frames do you
usually wear?

LAURA

Round frames, mostly.

DAVID

Ok, let's find something a bit different but that still meets your taste.

LAURA

Ok, yeah, why not?

DAVID

Which color?

LAURA

I've always worn black...Maybe something more colorful?

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We now see the iPad's interface and follow David's actions.

DAVID (V.O.)

Ok, so I'm going to filter all the models, except the round ones, and the colors available, just like this.

INT. STORE - DAY

Back with David and the customer.

DAVID

It's straightforward.

LAURA

Yeah, indeed! Oh, I like this one!

She points at a model.

DAVID

The brown one? Nice! What about the lenses?

LAURA

(a bit uncomfortable)
Oh well, I wouldn't know...

DAVID

Don't worry. The great thing about this tool is that we can try any lens available for the frame you choose to see which matches better.

LAURA

Great!

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We follow David's actions.

DAVID

Let's see. We have classic, gradient, and polarized. Oh, look at the green ones—stunning!

We see the lenses matched with the frame.

INT. STORE - DAY

Back with David and Laura.

LAURA

Oh my God, I love them.

David turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)

One more step and I'm sure we'll close the sale.

Back to Laura.

DAVID (CONT'D)

(to Laura)

So, here we are. We selected Ray-Ban sunglasses with a brown frame and green lenses. What do you think? Do you like them?

LAURA

Surprisingly, I do! I love them.

David turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)

You see? That's how it's done. Now, let's complicate the game. What if you have more customers to deal with? I sense the Smartshopper Tower will come in handy!

FADE OUT.

INT. STORE - DAY

Two customers, Lauren and Emma. Lauren is trying some optical models in front of a mirror. Emma doesn't seem very supportive. While giving random advice to her friend, she also browses the shelves for herself.

LAUREN

(putting the glasses on) And what about these?

Emma reaches Lauren in front of the mirror.

**EMMA** 

Mmm, no, they're too squared for your face.

LAUREN

(trying another pair)
And these?

**EMMA** 

No, I don't like them.

Emma goes back to the shelves. Lauren sighs, discouraged. Then, she meets David's glance in the mirror.

LAUREN

Excuse me, can you help me?

David, at the counter, turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)

Well, let's see if Smartshopper can be more supportive than her friend!

He takes the iPad with him and reaches Lauren.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Hello, how is it going?

LAUREN

(giggling nervously)

Not good.

DAVID

Ahah, okay. How can I help you?

LAUREN

Well, I need prescription glasses. It's the first time I buy them.

OK, do you have the prescription details already? Or do you need an eye test first?

LAUREN

No, I have them!

DAVID

Great. So, have you seen something interesting so far?

Emma jumps into the conversation while still browsing the shelves.

**EMMA** 

She is stuck with square shapes, but they're not right for her.

LAUREN

That's what SHE thinks; I disagree.

DAVID

Well, why don't we use the Frame Advisor to find out?

LAUREN

The what, sorry?

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David starts using his iPad. He selects the Frame Advisor tool inside Smartshopper.

DAVID (V.O.)

The Frame Advisor. It's a feature of our Smartshopper tool.

INT. STORE - DAY

David shows Lauren the iPad.

DAVID

Look at this. You just need to answer a few simple questions, and then the tool will help you select the shapes that better suit you.

LAUREN

No way!

Let's give it a try!

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David uses the Frame Advisor. We see him answering the questions for Lauren. The first question appears on the screen.

DAVID (V.O.)

Ok, so first of all, your jawline. I would say yours is... squared; what do you think?

INT. STORE - DAY

Lauren turns to the mirror.

LAUREN

Yeah, I would say so.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David selects the jawline shape. Then, the second question appears.

DAVID (V.O.)

And now your face shape. Round, rectangular, oval...?

INT. STORE - DAY

Lauren runs her fingers along her profile.

LAUREN

I'd go with Oval!

DAVID

Yeah, I agree.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David selects the Oval shape.

INT. STORE - DAY

David, in front of Lauren, turns to the camera.

The cool thing about Frame Advisor is that it allows you to get a complete picture of your customers' aesthetics. Just watch!

David turns back to Lauren.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Now, a more personal question. How would you describe your style?

LAUREN

Classic, very clean. I wouldn't say I like flashy things on me too much.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David navigates into the style categories and selects Lauren's preferences.

INT. STORE - DAY

David, next to Lauren, shows her the iPad.

DAVID

Ok, I have included your tailored suggestions below. What do you think?

LAUREN

Oh wow, so many!

DAVID

Oh, one last thing. What color would you like to try? Do you have any preferences?

LAUREN

I don't know...

DAVID

I would suggest black, grey, or even blue for a classic style!

LAUREN

Mmm, maybe light blue or purple, something like that.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David starts using the iPad again. He selects Lauren's preferences.

INT. STORE - DAY

David to Lauren.

DAVID

Okay, let's look at the models together and make a first selection. You can choose your favorites by clicking "like" and "dislike" here.

David shows Lauren the "Like" and "Dislike" buttons. Lauren selects 4 to 5 models.

David turns to the camera.

DAVID (CONT'D)

(to the camera)

Now that we have narrowed her preferences, it will be very easy to find the perfect model for her!

Then, back to Lauren.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Okay, now all you have to do is select the model you like best!

David shows Lauren the iPad again.

Emma stops looking at the shelves and reaches them, intrigued by their words.

LAUREN

Oh wow, thanks! So, any model here is available?

DAVID

Exactly, even the ones that are not physically in store.

Emma is now looking at the iPad with Lauren.

**EMMA** 

Is it also possible to try them on?

DAVID

Of course!

David activates the Virtual Mirror and hands the iPad to Lauren.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

Lauren uses the Virtual Mirror.

INT. STORE - DAY

Emma watches her captured.

INSERT: LAUREN'S PHONE SCREEN

Lauren tries the models she filtered. She tries a few until she finds the one she likes.

LAUREN

Oh yes, I think this is the one!

INT. STORE - DAY

Lauren shows Emma the iPad's screen with the glasses on.

LAUREN

What do you think?

**EMMA** 

Perfect! See? I told you round shapes were the best fit for you!

David turns to the camera.

DAVID

EMMA

Can I try this tool as well? I was looking for a new pair of sunglasses but can't find anything I like here!

David, still looking at the camera, smirks. Then he turns back to Lauren and Emma.

DAVID

Of course. Let me complete your friend's order, and I'll be right with you!

## **EMMA**

Alright, thanks!

David goes to the counter together with Lauren to complete the order. He then addresses the camera.

## DAVID

(to the camera)
One after the other...and it's
getting more and more complicated.
Are you curious about
Smartshopper's next adventure? See
you there!

FADE OUT.

Smartshopper\_A fresh pair of eyewear

INT. STORE - DAY

A middle-aged customer, PAUL, with his phone tries to take some photos of a sunglasses model displayed on the shelf.

David, behind the desk, watches him with a doubtful expression. He turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera) What is he doing?

Paul takes the sunglasses in one hand and tries to take some photos with the other.

David continues to look at him.

DAVID (CONT'D)

(to the camera)

Let's check on him!

David takes the iPad with him and reaches Paul.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Hello! Is everything alright?

Paul, not aware of David, jumps a little.

PAUL

Oh hello! Yes, thank you.

DAVID

Can I help you with anything?

PAUL

(mumbling)

No, mmm...well, yes, maybe... I mean, I wanted to take a photo of these sunglasses to show them to my wife.

DAVID

Ok, sure, would you like to take the photo trying them on?

PAUL

Oh no, just a picture of the glasses.

DAVID

Oh, ok, ehm...

PAUL

It's just that I'd rather not try on something already worn by someone else. My wife can tell me if they're right for me before I order them.

DAVID

Ohh right.

David turns to the camera.

DAVID (CONT'D)

(ironically to the camera)
If only there were a way to get a
pair directly from the factory,
which was just made for him, right?
Wouldn't it be great?

He shows the iPad to the camera.

DAVID (CONT'D)

(to the camera)

Well, I'm going to blow his mind in 3,2,1...

While David does the countdown with his fingers, he turns back to the client.

DAVID (CONT'D)

You know, you can try the sunglasses without actually putting them on. If you want to, of course.

Paul looks at him, surprised.

PAUL

Really? How?

David starts using his iPad.

DAVID

Ok, so you chose a Ray-Ban Wayfarer, acetate frame, grey...

PAUL

Yes, correct.

DAVID

Alright! Please follow me to the Tower.

David reaches the Tower, followed by Paul. David starts using the Tower, and a QR code appears on the screen.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Okay, so you need to scan this QR code with your phone.

Paul scans the QR code.

INSERT: PAUL'S PHONE SCREEN

A link appears on the screen.

DAVID (V.O.)

Now, click on the link.

Paul clicks on the link. The screen turns into a virtual mirror, and we see Paul wearing sunglasses.

PAUL

(on-screen)

Oh wow, that's amazing!

INT. STORE - DAY

David stands before Paul while he's trying the sunglasses with Smartshopper.

DAVID

Yeah, right? And now, if you like, you can also take a picture and send it to your wife!

Paul looks at David, amused.

INSERT: PAUL'S PHONE SCREEN

We see Paul taking his photo.

INT. STORE - DAY

David observes Paul while he texts his wife.

DAVID

If we'll get her approval, I will order a freshly made pair for you!

PAUL

That sounds great! Oh, she's calling me.

Paul answers the phone.

PAUL (CONT'D)

Ehi sweetie! Yes, they're great, right?

David smiles and moves away. He goes back behind the counter.

DAVID

(to the camera)

It sounds like we have the green light! I'll ask him if he prefers to have them delivered to the store or directly to his home, and we'll be done!

Paul stops talking to his phone for a moment and turns towards David.

PAUL

What's the tool's name?

DAVID

Smartshopper!

Paul nods as a thank you and goes back to his phone call.

Suddenly, David catches a glimpse of another customer's conversation.

NEW CUSTOMER (V.O.)

(on the phone)

Yes, I'm in the store right now, but honestly, I don't know if it was a good idea... I hope to find something.

David smirks at the camera, then takes his iPad and exits the frame.

FADE OUT.

Smartshopper\_The wedding gift

INT. STORE - DAY

At the counter. Joey, a customer in his late 20s, watches the iPad's screen. David is next to him, holding the iPad.

JOEY

It's not that they're not cool, I mean...

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

Joey scrolls the screen, showing two Aviator models, one in silver, thin-framed, and the other bold and black.

DAVID (V.O.)

You were saying they're going to Mexico for their honeymoon, right? Surely, they'll come in handy there!

INT. STORE - DAY

Joey repeatedly scrolls the screen, watching one model, then the other. He is not convinced.

JOEY

Yeah...

David turns to the camera. The camera moves, showing the exit, then goes back on David, who followed its movement with his head.

DAVID

(to the camera)

No, he's not walking away. He's just a bit overwhelmed, that's all. Being the best man is always a big responsability, especially regarding the gift. But I know how to help him. Just watch!

David goes back to Joey.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Let me ask you: what's really concerning you?

JOEY

I don't know; it seemed like a good idea at the beginning.

And now?

JOEY

Now I'm like, well, I mean, this is certainly a good gift, and these sunglasses are gorgeous. But I feel like I'm doing something meaningless.

DAVID

Yeah, I know what you mean. But, try to see it this way. Aviator is one of Ray-Ban's most iconic styles. It's timeless; it never gets old, just like true love.

JOEY

(still not convinced)
Mmm yeah...

DAVID

And...

David turns to the camera, smiles, then goes back to Joey.

DAVID (CONT'D)

To make it even more special, you can customize them with the bride and groom's names or their wedding date engraved on the temples.

Joey lights up.

JOEY

Really? Can we do that?

DAVID

Our Smartshopper tool can do anything!

David shows Joey how the models can be personalized.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We follow David's actions on screen. He shows how the engraving can be done on the temples of one of the two models.

DAVID (V.O.)

We can add their initials here internally. What do you think?

INT. STORE - DAY

Joey, looking at the screen.

JOEY

Can we add both their initials and wedding date?

DAVID

Of course.

JOEY

OK, so Rebecca and John, R and J. And the 26th of June is the wedding date.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

David shows the engraving on the bride's model.

INT. STORE - DAY

Joey, looking at the screen.

JOEY

(enthusiastic)

Cool!

David turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)

And it gets better. I'm going to offer him to do the same with the cases!

He goes back to David.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Would you like to engrave the cases as well?

JOEY

Yes, of course!

DAVID

Perfect. So, if you're happy with your choice, let's complete the engraving on both models, shall we?

JOEY

Yeah, let's do it!

David turns to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)
He will definitely make an
impression with these personalized
Aviators!

He turns to Joey again. While they're completing the order on the iPad, a bike helmet hits the counter. We don't see the person who owns the helmet.

David raises his eyes from the iPad and looks at the helmet. Then smiles at the camera.

DAVID (CONT'D)
Let's take Smartshopper for a ride!

FADE OUT.

Smartshopper\_The Perfect Glasses for the Race

INSERT: DAVID'S PHONE SCREEN

This is a close-up of a picture in which David and another guy (MILES) are cycling. They're wearing technical clothes and accessories, and it's clear they are very into this sport.

DAVID (V.O.)

Good, old times.

INT. STORE - DAY

The frame widens to reveal David in the middle of the store, showing his phone to two cyclists next to him: Zoe and Miles. They're between 30 and 35 years old and dressed in cycling clothes.

Miles gives David a pat on the back.

MILES

Come on, not so old!

ZOE

Do you still ride sometimes?

DAVID

Yeah, I do. But just for fun.

Miles shares a glance with the other two. David gets suspicious.

DAVID (CONT'D)

What?

MILES

Ok, let's get straight to the point. Zoe and I will participate in a race as a team next month. We need brand new, top-of-the-line sunglasses and... a new team member. I told Zoe you were the perfect man for both requests!

David turns panicked to the camera.

DAVID

(to the camera)

Can Smartshopper grow a pair of wheels?

He goes back to Miles and Zoe.

DAVID (CONT'D)

Well, guys, I don't know about the race, but I have just the right tool to help you choose your perfect pair. Wait a second.

David goes to the counter and takes his iPad. Then goes back to Miles and Zoe.

DAVID (CONT'D)

There it is, Smartshopper, our online catalog. Here, you have thousands of models to choose from.

ZOE

Oh, nice!

DAVID

Do you both need glasses?

MILES

Yes, we'd like to have matching pairs for the race.

DAVID

Ok, perfect! If I know you well, Miles, I think we can already filter your preferences for Oakley models, right?

MILES

(turning to Zoe)

Yeah, we can all agree on this.

Zoe nods.

DAVID

Ook, so...

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We follow David's actions. He clicks on the entry point dedicated to Oakley Custom, and Oakley models appear. He writes "Jawbreaker" on the search bar.

DAVID (V.O.)

What about Jawbreaker? It's great for any weather condition.

INT. STORE - DAY

Miles and Zoe take a look at the model on the iPad.

MILES

Yeah, they're valid. But we'd prefer a high-performing model on the road. Do you have Sutro in there?

DAVID

Of course!

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We see David search for Sutro.

DAVID (V.O.)

It features impact protection and, paired with Prizm Road lenses, allows you to see subtle changes in the road texture!

Prizm Road Lenses are selected.

INT. STORE - DAY

Miles and Zoe watch the screen.

MILES

There we are!

DAVID

What about the frame color? Any idea?

MILES

Mmm, I don't know...Blue perhaps?

ZOE

Let's make it white with blue details, like our race suit!

MILES

Yeah, great idea!

DAVID

Alright, done! And what about the wicket?

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

Wicket color options are shown.

INT. STORE - DAY

Miles looks at the iPad.

MILES

I'd go with polished white.

We see David selecting the option.

DAVID

Done! Oh, quick thought: if you want to personalize it even more, you can engrave your initials or your team's name on them.

MILES

No way! Let's put our team's name then! We call ourselves "Cyclomaniacs".

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We see David while he inserts the text for the engraving.

INT. STORE - DAY

David shows Miles and Zoe the iPad again.

DAVID

What do you think?

ZOE

They're awesome! I can't wait to wear them.

MILES

Come on, man, order a pair for yourself as well.

David looks at them, not knowing what to do. Then, he activates the Virtual Mirror on the iPad.

INSERT: IPAD'S SCREEN

We see David on screen with the glasses on.

DAVID

Oh, what the heck, why not?

He smirks at the camera through the iPad's screen.

FADE OUT.

Smartshopper Pro\_Conclusion

INT. EXHIBITION SPACE, 2° ROOM - DAY

We start from the last scene of the previous script. Ava, Sophie, Robert, and Eric look at the iPads and chat with each other about Smartshopper. Gerard is next to them.

GERARD

(to the group)
So, what is Smartshopper's great
potential?

The camera gets closer to his face.

GERARD (CONT'D)

Any volunteers?

INT. STUDIO INTERVIEW/EXHIBITION SPACE B-ROLL - MONTAGE

Instead of Gerard, we have the four opticians now being interviewed. We see them talking to the off-screen interviewer, one at a time. Their interviews alternate with quick b-rolls of them in the exhibition room with Gerard.

## ROBERT

Robert sits on a folding chair. He looks around, clearly uncomfortable. It's probably the first time he's done an interview. Suddenly, he looks straight ahead, realizing the camera is already rolling. He needs to answer the question.

## ROBERT

Oh, right...ehm, well, we can't ignore the extent of technology anymore. But I love that Smartshopper is so intuitive and very easy to integrate into the selling ritual.

B-rolls of him with Eric and Gerard during the role-play scene (video 2) take turns. They're caught in the moment the scene is over, and they're laughing together, proud of their performance.

ROBERT (V.O.)

You'll just need an iPad to carry around the store. IGbelieve it's going to boost our work.

Back to Robert's interview.

ROBERT

(smiling)

It will be any optician's secret weapon.

SOPHIE

Sophie, confident, sits elegantly on the folding chair. She's already in the middle of her interview.

SOPHIE

And the experience provided in store is beyond. Take the customization feature, for instance.

B-rolls of Sophie looking at Gerard's customized sunglasses take turns.

SOPHIE (V.O.)

Even the most demanding customer will feel valued by having the possibility to make their glasses unique. Sometimes, simply adding just a special little touch to them. This magic also allows us to know our customers more intimately and deeply.

Back to Sophie's interview.

SOPHIE

And because it's a customized item, they will probably understand its worth and agree to pay even more.

ERIC

Casual but stylish, Eric talks confidently to the interviewer.

ERIC

But it's not just a tool to sell more, cross-sell, or upsell. It carries a new business model that allows us to reduce the risk of obsolescence, rationalizing inventory. AVA

With the iPad in her hands, Ava sits with her legs crossed, very at ease.

AVA

Customers will understand they don't need to go anywhere else to find what they desire.

**ERIC** 

Back to Eric's interview.

ERIC

And that will increase their retention and store loyalty.

END OF MONTAGE

INT. EXHIBITION SPACE, 2° ROOM - DAY

Gerard is now alone in the room. He puts the iPads back on the wall and looks around to check that everything is in the right place. We start hearing him in v.o.

GERARD (V.O.)

No matter how big or small a store is, if you meet a very picky customer, satisfying their specific request can sometimes be a hard challenge. And the result is they could leave your store with a good compromise.

INT. EXHIBITION SPACE, ON CAMERA

Gerard is now in front of the camera, looking at the offscreen interviewer.

GERARD
